COMPETITIVE TEAM AGREEMENT INITIAL EACH POLICY

_A valid credit card on file is required as a member of the Zenith Gymnastics Team Program. No exceptions. If tuition is not received by the 7th of the month the card on file will be charged in full plus an additional 10% late fee on the 15th of the month. If card is declined child may not participate in practice and/or competitions until balance is paid in full.

There is a \$5/month discount for setting up auto-draft for tuition fees. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE COACH'S EXPENSES/MEET FEES. COACH'S EXPENSES/MEET FEES MUST BE PAID SEPARATELY AND IN ADDITION TO TUITION BY THE 15TH OF THE MONTH.

_ A written 30-day drop notice is required to drop without penalty of 1 month's tuition. The drop notice must be received on the 1st of the month prior to the month dropping. Tuition will not be prorated. Zenith Gymnastics reserves the right to cancel your team membership at the time of the drop if deemed necessary. Zenith Gymnastics also reserves the right to request the gymnast to leave early after the 30-day notice is received.

Zenith Gymnastics reserves the right to expel any team member and/or parent(s) from the program. A gymnast can be expelled if their work ethic or attitude causes a negative atmosphere or possible harm to themselves or others in the program. Expulsion is at the discretion of the coach(es). Parents can be expelled if it is determined they are detrimental to the program or gymnasts. This can result from a parent bad mouthing the program, coaches or gymnasts. Zenith Gymnastics will not be responsible for reimbursement of any expenses including: competition fees, travel expenses, uniforms, tuition, registration fees or camps/clinics, etc. as a result of the expulsion and/or resignation from the team.

Parents are not allowed on the gym floor. Please do not coach your child from the sideline for their safety and respect for the coaches. Parents will be banned from the observation areas if found negligent of this policy.

_____ If it is determined that a gymnast is not competition ready, the coach can pull a gymnast from a competition.

Participation with Zenith Gymnastics Competitive Team is a YEARLY commitment. Gymnasts are expected to be at all practice and competitions. No refunds/credits will be given for tuition, registration fee, competition expenses, travel expenses, clinics, uniforms, team photos and/or camp fees regardless of termination/resignation date. There are no make ups or tuition credits for missed and/or cancelled practices including those due to natural disasters and/or acts of god.

Team Coach's Expenses/Meet fees will be due on the 15th of the month (payment schedule attached). If payment is not received by the 15th of the month additional 10% late fees will accrue monthly. Additionally, child will not participate in competitions until balance including late fees are paid in full. There will be NO REFUNDS of these fees for any reason, even if you do not attend a meet.

Team members must carry their own primary health insurance policy to cover any/all medical expenses. If a gymnast is injured they are required to continue attending all training. Their training will be modified based on injury.

Team members will be entered into competitions at the discretion of their coach(es). Team members are required to own competitive team uniform every year which may include but not limited to: competitive leotard/tank, pommel pants & shorts (boys only) & competitive warm-up pants and jacket. No refunds or exchanges will be given.

Team uniform payments will be required at time of annual uniform sizing (usually in May). If uniform sizing and/or uniform order deadline is missed for any reason; additional costs will be incurred to place order separately and the risk is run that uniform may not be received in time for competition.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OR RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT ("AGREEMENT")

In consideration of participating in the Zenith Gymnastics Competition Team, classes or special events, I represent that I understand the nature of this activity and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity, I acknowledge that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the activity.

I fully understand that this activity involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the event takes place, or the negligence of the participant name below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, cost, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the activity.

I hereby, release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Zenith Gymnastics, LLC. its affiliates, its respective administrators, directors, agents, offices, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and leasers' of premises on which the activity takes place, (each considered one of the "releasers" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages, on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releases" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operation and future agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasers, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasers from any loss, liability, damage, or cost, which any may incur as the result of such claim. If claim is filed I understand it must be filed in the county the incident occurred.

GYM RULES

For Gymnasts

- 1. Gymnasts are expected to arrive on time and stay until the end of their practice time. If they are unable to do so their coach must be informed before practice starts.
- 2. Gymnasts should stay inside until they are picked up after practice. They are not allowed to go outside or wait in the parking lot.
- 3. Gymnasts are expected to wear appropriate attire. We recommend shorts that DO NOT have pockets for boys. Girls should wear a leotard, without shorts or pants.
- 4. Gymnasts should bring their grips to each practice.
- 5. Gymnasts are expected to be respectful and listen to their coaches. They are also expected to follow all safety rules while they are inside the facility.
- 6. If there are any problems or concerns, gymnasts should let their coaches know so that the coaches can handle any problems. One of the coaches will call parents if the gymnast is sick, injured, or needs to be picked up for any other reason.
- 7. No food or drink is allowed inside the gym, including lockers, except for water bottles that can be closed.
- 8. Gymnasts are expected to keep their lockers clean. Lockers are for storage of grips, water bottles, cell phones, and wallets. Coaches are free to check lockers for cleanliness at random times. Gymnasts that consistently do not keep their locker clean may lose their locker privileges.
- 9. Cell phone use during practice times is not allowed. Gymnasts are expected to leave their cell phones in their lockers and not use them until practice has ended. Gymnasts that use their cell phones during practice without prior permission form the coaches will be asked to leave their cell phones in the front office until practice is over.

For Parents

- 1. Parents should make sure that their gymnasts arrive on time and wearing proper attire.
- 2. To limit interruptions during practice, parents should schedule a time before or after practice to talk to the coaches. They can also e-mail the coaches directly if they have any questions or concerns about practice times, levels, specific skills, competitions, or anything that occurs during practice. Parents should e-mail the office for any questions about tuition payments or competition fees.
- 3. If a gymnast must leave early or will miss practice, the coaches should be told before practice starts in person, by text, or by e-mail.
- 4. Parents should watch from one of the viewing areas if they are staying during practice.
- 5. Parents should come inside to pick up their child if they are dropping off and not staying. Gymnasts are not allowed to wait outside to be picked up.
- 6. Parents are required to discuss any injuries with their gymnast's coach, even if they were not sustained during practice. This is to ensure that coaches are aware of any limitations or problems that may arise during practice and to minimize the chance of further injury (or exacerbation of the injury).
